



Mixed Messages at the Western Wall: What's Happening With the Kotel Compromise?

After dozens of Haredim disrupt mixed prayer service in Kotel plaza, Netanyahu says he is committed to egalitarian prayer space.

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has reiterated his commitment to an egalitarian prayer space at the Western Wall, following ugly scenes at the Kotel on Thursday when dozens of Haredi protesters disrupted a prayer service by non-Orthodox Jews.

In what may have been his first words on the subject in Hebrew, Netanyahu said: "At a time when we are continuing in our efforts to reach a solution that will allow every Jew to feel at home at the Western Wall, there are those who would prefer to divide our people and even declare that other Jews are wicked or not Jews at all. We must reject these words and these inappropriate acts that are opposed to the fundamental spirit of the State of Israel."

Health Minister Yaakov Litzman, the head of the ultra-Orthodox United Torah Judaism party, responded to Netanyahu's comments. "As we have known throughout the generations, the Western Wall is the holiest site for the Jewish people and one of the values closest to the heart of every Jew," he said. "At a time when we are acting to continue to preserve this holy place, when all the world is looking toward it in holiness and longing, there are those who would prefer to ... harm the holiness of the site and its purity, God forbid."



Mediterranean Eggplant Dip

Babaganoush is a Mediterranean eggplant dip, commonly served at Shabbat meals with salads and Middle Eastern dips like hummus, tahini and matbucha. It's not difficult to make, and you can tweak it to your family's preferences.

Prick the eggplant on all sides and bake at 400° F for about 2 hours. The eggplant should look shrivelled when ready.

Slit the eggplant open lengthwise and scoop out the insides (everything except the actual peel). Put the eggplant and garlic cloves into the bowl of a food processor and pulse until puréed. You can use garlic powder instead, if you prefer, in which case add the powder later, with the other ingredients.

Wait for the eggplant to reach room temperature, and then add the mayonnaise, lemon juice and salt. Refrigerate until ready to serve. Some people use tahini instead of mayonnaise.

You can eat it as a dip with challah, or a spread on toast. It also makes a great dip for veggie sticks.

Ingredients:

- 1 medium-sized eggplant
- 1 tbsp. mayonnaise
- ♦ 1 tbsp. lemon juice
- ♦ 1–2 small garlic cloves (or ¼ tsp. garlic powder)
- ♦ ¾ tsp. kosher salt

Directions:

- 1. Prick eggplant with a fork on all sides. Bake at 400° F for 2 hours. Eggplant should look shrivelled when ready.
- 2. Cut eggplant in half lengthwise and scoop out the insides.
- 3. Put eggplant and garlic in a food processor and pulse until puréed.
- 4. Let the mixture cool to room temperature. Then mix in the mayonnaise, salt and lemon juice.
- 5. Refrigerate until serving.

Yields: 1 cup

You may find this a surprisingly informative, unbiased and eloquent brief view of the South Africa's history into and out of apartheid – by the PM who shared the Nobel Peace Prize with Nelson Mandela..

However, we had very real concerns:

- Nearly everywhere else in Africa one-man, one vote elections had led to chaos, military governments and economic collapse.
- How would our minorities be able to protect themselves in a one-man, one-vote situation?
- We were also worried about the SACP's influence within the ANC. During the 70s and 80s virtually all the members of the ANC's National Executive Committee were also members of the SACP.

The unrest of the mid-1980s brought PW Botha's reform initiatives to a jarring halt while order was restored in the wake of the draconian state of emergency that was imposed in June, 1986.

Then, toward the end of the 1980s, the situation began to change for the better:

- South Africa, Angola and Cuba reached agreement on the withdrawal of Cuban troops from Angola and the implementation of the UN independence plan for Namibia;
- The Namibian independence process showed that positive outcomes could be achieved through negotiations;
- By 1987 all the main South African parties including the ANC and the Government had accepted that there could not be an armed solution:
- After the fall of the Berlin Wall in November, 1989 we realised that the time would never again be so propitious for successful constitutional negotiations so we decided to move ahead with negotiations as quickly as possible.

History had opened a window of opportunity for us. On 2 February 1990 we removed the last remaining obstacles to negotiations - including the unbanning of all political parties and the release of Nelson Mandela.

After almost four years of roller coaster negotiations we finally succeeded, in December 1993, in reaching agreement on an interim Constitution which secured the core interests of all of the main parties.

Ironically, the climax of my presidency came on 10 May 1994 on the day that I ceased to be President. I felt fulfilled because I had relinquished power - not to Nelson Mandela or the ANC - but to a new dispensation in which the Constitution and the Rule of Law - and not the government of the day - would be supreme.

The rest, as they say, is history.

What have I learned from all of this?

Firstly, the corrosive nature of power. Lord Acton was right: power tends to corrupt and absolute power corrupts absolutely. The problem before 1994 was that Parliament was supreme. It could - and it did - make any law that it pleased.

It is also true that, in the absence of deeply ingrained values and strong and independent watchdogs, those who have power will tend to abuse it to promote their personal and political interests.

That is why it is so important to limit and monitor the power of governments and political leaders.

The lesson is that we should do everything we can to defend the watchdogs of our Constitution. They are under threat - particularly the National Prosecuting Authority and the Hawks. At the same time, our courts - and our Public Protector - continue to act independently and fearlessly.

Secondly, I have learned that the worst episodes of human history have been caused by ideologies: just think of the 120 million victims of Nazism, Fascism and Communism during the past century.

Ideologists develop theories about how to achieve an ideal society and then try to force reality into the narrow channels of their theories.

· Ideologies all have millenarian visions: the classless society; manifest destiny; or the thousand year Reich.

They all conjure up enemies: liberals, the bourgeoisie; or the Jews.

- They all ignore realities that do not fit in with their theories.
- They all trample on the interests of ordinary people in order to achieve their goals.

South Africa suffered under the ideologies of apartheid and separate development.

Now, once again, the ANC is trying to force the complex realities of South Africa into the narrow channels of the National Democratic Revolution. Its millenarian vision is the establishment of a National Democratic Society in which the economic and cultural space of each race would be pegged to the percentage of the population that it represents. It is leading to the racialisation of our society in which many aspects of people's lives will once again be determined by the colour of their skin rather than the content of their character.

We even have some of the world's last communists who believe that the NDR is the best route to the achievement of a communist state!


