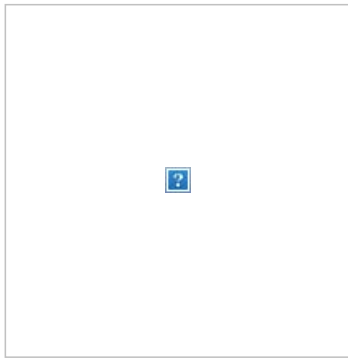

HOD HISTORY

Bro Alan Sandler shared a remarkable (his)story with me.

He recently attended a function and was introduced to someone who mentioned a name from his past, Lorraine Lotzof. Her name came up because he was the partner of Lorraine's late husband, and hearing that Alan was from South Africa, asked if he knew her in the old days. Lorraine's late husband was a track star representing the USA at the 1965 Maccabi Games, which is where he and Lorraine met.

Lorraine was a track star who was selected to represent South Africa at the 1965 Maccabi Games in Israel. Her coach was none other than Alan's father, who was a Springbok and Maccabi selector. Alan has fond memories of being with his Dad, watching her train.

Alan was sent a copy of Lorraine's book about her life, called "My Race". In it, she tells that it was her Grandfather and his brother who founded HOD in South Africa over a hundred years ago!!!!



JEWISH INTEREST

On this date, in 1961, the first Freedom Riders--seven African-Americans and six whites --set out in two buses from Washington D.C., headed for New Orleans, to challenge segregationist transportation laws that the Supreme Court had declared unconstitutional. One group was viciously attacked on Mother's Day by a Ku Klux Klan mob in Anniston, Alabama, and their bus was set ablaze. The Freedom Riders persisted throughout the year, confronting violence and arrest with non-violent resistance

that inspired tremendous courage among the Southern blacks who would be mobilized as the rank-and-file activists of the civil rights movement. Of some 440 Freedom Riders, half were white, and more than a quarter of these were Jewish.

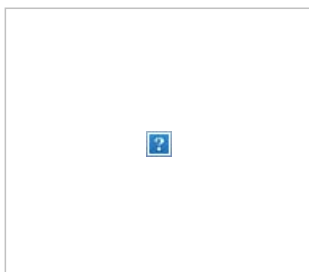
